Lucy Fowlkes Breed was a long-time volunteer, founding and dedicating over twenty years as the facilitator of the New Parents Support Group at the Children's Place and Parent Education Center in Concord. Lucy also served as a founding trustee on the board of New Hampshire Children's Trust, dedicating fourteen years as board member, eight of those years as board chair. Upon her retirement, New Hampshire Children's Trust set up the Lucy Fowlkes Breed Legacy Fund and created the award in her honor.
