The nationally adopted Standards of Quality for Family Strengthening and Support are used across the country by public departments, foundations, networks, community-based organizations, and families as a tool for planning, providing, and assessing quality practice. These standards are based on the Principles of Family Support Practice and the Strengthening Families Framework and its research-based, evidence-informed 5 Protective Factors. The Standards have created a common language across different kinds of Family Strengthening and Support programs. Participants qualify for certification by the National Family Support Network.
